→**TEXTBOOKS**: Textbooks would be available for sale during the holidays to avoid delays when school resumes, selling commences on Aug 6<sup>th</sup> at the school bookshop, near the Admin office. Please note,when school resumes it might take up to 3 days before books will be allocated after payment, as we might run out of initial stock. The costs of the textbooks are in your bill/invoice.

However, where textbooks, notebooks etc. are lost by a child, it can be repurchased by the parent from the book shop. →UNIFORMS: All Uniforms are available, please use this opportunity to replace outgrown and overused uniforms, neatness and self-esteem is a culture we imbibe in our little ones as the grow, coming to School in neat uniforms is ideal we want them to stand out in this community
