PTA/OPEN DAY: The PTA/Open Day was successfully held, I appreciate all parents that were in attendance and implore those who did not come to try to keep the date for PTA/Open free on their activity plans. There is need for you to visit the school to check on the progress of your child/ward and contribute to the progress of the school.

NOTEABLE INFORMATION:-

Resumption:- Third term begins on Monday 29th April 2019. All students are expected to be in school by 7.30am
Payment of fees is on or before resumption. However a grace of two weeks might be given after resumption, after which students will be sent back home. Any student who fails to resume on the said date will pay a fine of N5,000.00 unless permission is granted.

BOARDING:- All boarding students are to resume on Sunday 28th April, 2019. Checking in of students will end by 5pm. All boarding students are please warned to adhere to the rules and regulations of the hostel. Any who violates the laws will be D-boarded. Parents are please reminded that no cash will be given to any child. All funds must be handed over to the hostel mistress at the point of checking in.

Students are not allowed to take in any form of food or drink into the rooms. Whether school food or food from home. Any student that violates these must be instantly asked to leave the hostel. All

kinds of food and drinks MUST be taken at the sitting room at the ground floor.

Use of wrong uniform:- For the sake of those that joined and old students who might have forgotten, below are our dress codes.

1. **Hairdo:** Style chosen by the school must be made. It lasts for two weeks before changing. However if a child feels her hair do is rough such a child can re-do the same style to appear neat. For boys clean hair cut without carving.

2. **School shoes:-** The school shoe is black shoe without any silver or gold accessories attached to it. No black canvas can be used in place of black as such will be seized.

Use of Gargets:- The school prohibits the use of any electronical gargets, cellphone, and movable sound systems. Any of such found with students MUST be seized and never to be given back. This has been our policy and will continue to be so.

However students can come in with cellphones or cameras on days of ceremonies like cultural day, graduation or inter-house sports BUT at the owner's risk.

Don't even dare come to report when stolen.

Extension Classes:- As the school vacates on 10th April JS3 and SS3 will continue their classes as from Monday 15th April 2019 and go on Easter break on Monday – Thursday before Good Friday. Classes resume back on Tuesday 23rd April 2019. During this period SS3 will be writing their WAEC exams.

All students MUST be on their school blue shirt/blouse on the trouser or skirt. Classes run from 9am to 1pm Monday to Thursday. No bus service please.

WAEC: - SS3 students have commenced their WAEC exams on Monday 8th April till May and NECO from June to July. We covet your prayers for their success. Parents please warn your wards to desist from any form of malpractice.

SUSPENSION FEES:- Any student who bags suspension for misconduct, will serve the suspension and on resumption from the suspension pays a suspension fee of N25,000.00 (Twenty-Five Thousand Naira) only. The school pleads with the parents

to avoid coming to plead for leniency, rather warn your ward to avoid it.

CHECKING OF RESULTS:- It has been observed that most parents do not check the results of the students from the internet using the scratch cards given to them in first term. This is disheartening as the progress of the student will not be monitored by the parents.

Message is always sent on the parents' platform as soon as the results are uploaded.

PRE-RESUMPTION TEST:- This is done at the first week of resumption. The topics to read are at the back of every question paper. Parents please ensure your ward reads to enable him/her answer the questions. It is part of the termly examination.

FIELD TRIP TO GHANA:- We were supposed to go on field trip to Ghana. But due to low response from our parents, it has been postponed to 1st June, 2019. The postponement is to give parents opportunity of meeting up with the payment for the trip. I earnestly plead

with you to let your child be part of the trip. It will be very educational. May God provide for us in Jesus Name.

Requirement for the trip includes an ECOWAS passport or international passport for the child.

Toiletries, underwear, night wears, shoe, sandals, and slippers.

SUCCESS TAB:- The purchase of this success tabs is still in progress. Those who made their payments had been supplied. Some are yet to be supplied. Parents whose children have can attest that it is of good value for the students. It aids their study habits. However, parents email addresses are required to block sites in the tablet that students are not supposed to enter.
